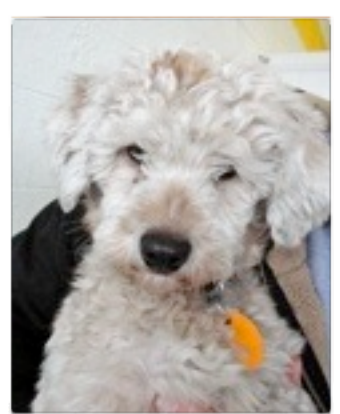

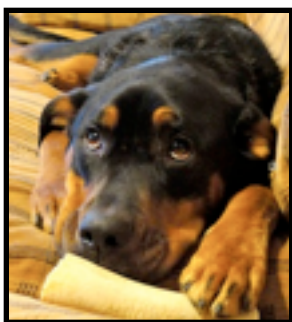
Save the Date!

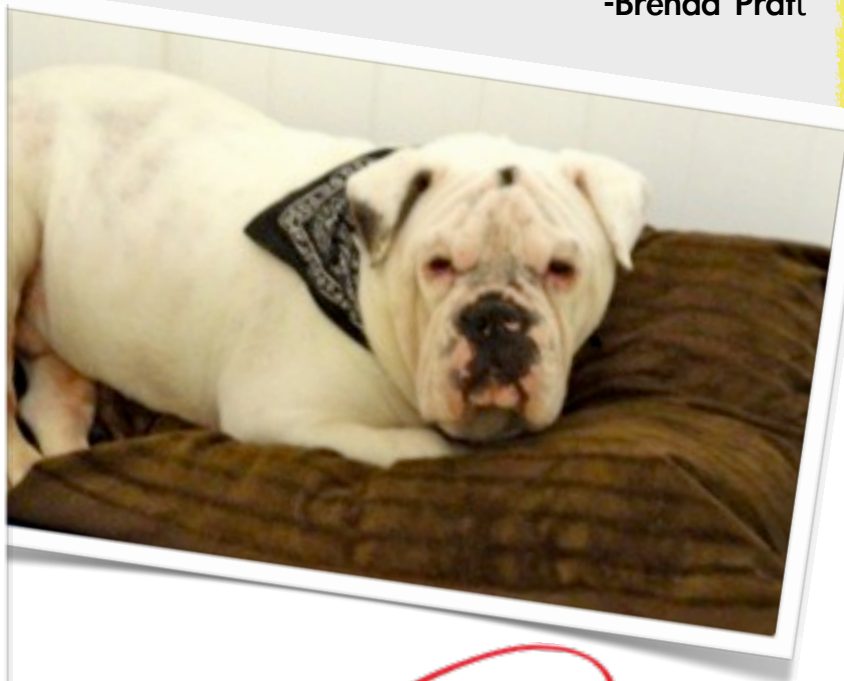
Warm, Fuzzy Tails

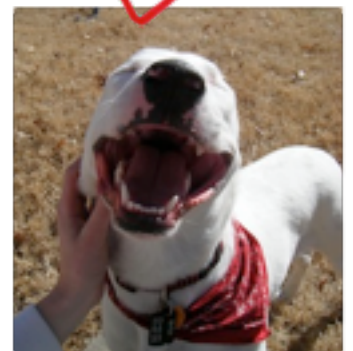
